Globally, **fewer than 6 out of 10 children** can read by the end of primary.




Disparities in reading


By gender: Boys are 10% less likely than girls to acquire foundational reading skills. Out-of-school children are 50% less likely to acquire foundational reading skills than those in school. Dut-of-school children are 50% less likely to acquire foundational reading skills than the richest. Disparities among countries

The richest children in **poorer countries** have **lower levels of reading proficiency** than the **poorest** children in **richer countries**
